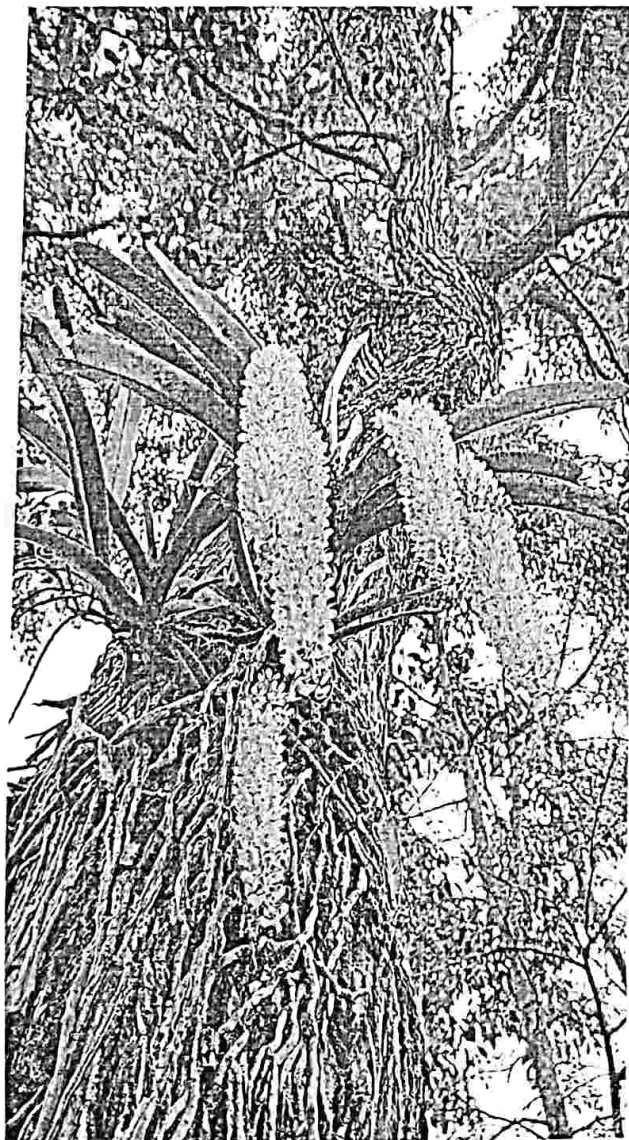
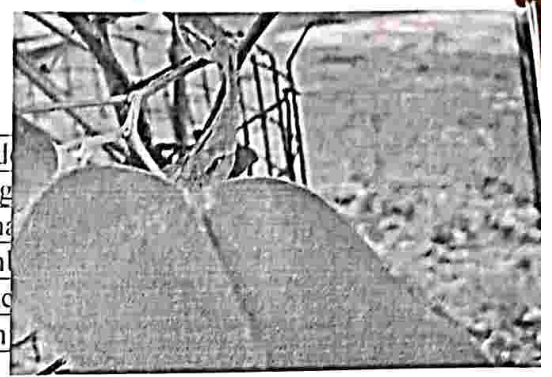

The electronic wastes like obsolete computer, laptops, Monitors, printers, scanners, are repaired and reused and those irreparable are sold out.

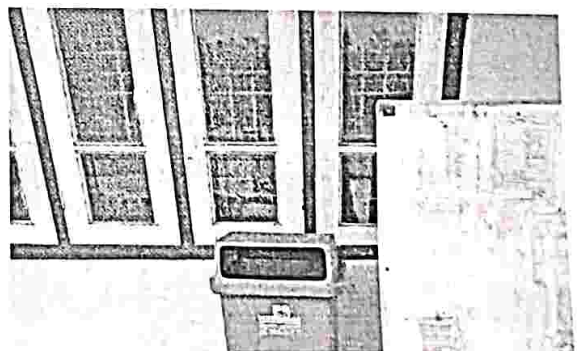

2. To reduce non-biodegradable wastes, plastic cups, plates, disposable bottles, etc. are replaced by paper made items.
3. Students are taking parts in Swacha Bharat Abhiyan. NSS volunteers are cleaning the college campus and neighbouring villages.
4. Fiex used for publicity or as banner are reused or disposed of properly.
5. Proper maintenance of infrastructure and timely repair of furniture are done to minimize solid waste.
