Feedback Analysis Report of Students, Teachers, Parents, Alumni, Employer and Non-Teaching Staff for the last Five Years (2019 to 2024):

The IQAC, Kamargaon College is applying the feedback mechanism to enhance the overall development of the institution. During the year, feedback has been taken from students, teachers, parents, alumni, employer and non teaching staff in order to evaluate the quality of education of the institution. The findings of the feedback reports during the last five years are given below:

Session: 2023-2024

Students feedback:

- Most of the students feel that the syllabus of UG courses is satisfactory, and the classroom teaching of the college is highly beneficial in achieving their academic purpose.
- Most of the students opined that their teachers regularly use audio visual aids in classroom teaching.
- Most of the students expressed that their teachers regularly use various kinds of technological tools in their respective classroom teaching.
- Students also responded that the texts and reference books prescribed in their syllabus are highly available in the central library of the college.
- It is also revealed from the responses of the students that a huge number of students are willing to apply for various jobs.
- The students have also responded well in terms of practices of various skills by the departments.


- Moreover, most of the students responded that they acquire satisfactory behavior inside the college campus.
- > They also opined that they would like to work as alumni with the college in future.
- > Majority of students stated in their responses that they are interested for higher education.
- Some students are interested in vocational and professional courses also.

From the responses of the students, Following suggestions are found:

- More vocational and professional subjects should be introduced.
- > Internet facilities should be improved.
- Constant mentoring and remedial classes are needed.
- > Course wise teachers should be appointed.

Teachers' feedback:

- > A large number of teachers opined that the infrastructural facilities provided by the institution are satisfactory.

- > Most of the teachers responded that the college authority encourages extension and other co curricular activities in the college campus and in the nearby educational institutions.
- > More than 80% of the total teachers are familiar with the latest and effective teaching learning tools and they apply these tools in their classroom teaching.
- > Most of the teachers offer personal counseling to the needy student and they actively engage in the field trips for enhancement of the experiential learning.
- > Teachers also expressed their opinion that they are actively engaging in various kinds of research-based activities like writing and publishing research papers, presentation of





seminar papers in national and international conferences and seminars, participation in faculty development programmes and workshops etc. for their professional development.

Teachers have provided the following suggestions for the development of the college:

- More vocational courses should be provided by including practical knowledge.
- ➤ Well equipped infrastructure is needed for smooth functioning of the classroom transaction.
- More collaborative cultural events with the local communities should be organized as the college is located at a tribal dominant area.
- > The institution should undertake on campus placement sessions.

Parents' feedback:

- > The parents have shown their satisfaction over the facilities provided by the college.
- Most of the parents viewed that they are highly satisfied with the progress of their children.
- > The parents also expressed their opinion that the college address grievances whenever required and assist the students.
- > The parents feel that they are able to maintain a healthy relationship with the institution.
- > They have also opined that the sports facility in the campus is adequate.

Feedback of Alumni:

- ➤ It is revealed that they are satisfied with the different facilities provided in the college campus.
- > They also expressed positive responses in promoting sports culture among the students of the college.
- > It is also found that most of the alumni expressed happiness and are interested to maintain a close and healthy relationship with the institution in near future.



Feedback of the Employer:

- > The employer of the institution regularly monitor the implementation of curricula, completion of syllabi, classes as per central routine and continuous internal evaluation.
