The sitting deliberated a wide range of issues and made the following decisions:-

The sitting also chose the other persons of the IQAC as per NAAC guidelines and chose the Circle officer, Revenue Dept., a Magistrate, and a Senior officer, Agriculture Dept. of the Borakhaï subdivision under Golaghat district for their suggestions, recommendations and Co-operation in the upliftment of the institution in future. Moreover the sitting choose Mr. Mohan Saikia as local representative, Tarun Singh Chelga as a stakeholder, The chief medical practitioner of Kamalgaoon MPTC, the chief manager of Numaligach Tea Estate and others required in the IQAC including the teachers and student representatives as per the guidelines.

② The sitting decided to re-nominate all the committees, cells and other functional bodies of the college and apprised them briefly about their tasks. The sitting decided the names of the various committees and cells and their names had been recorded subsequently to intimate the persons in due course.

- ⑪ The meeting decided to study the viabilities and possibilities to grow some tourist places in the division in collaboration with the divisional authority.
