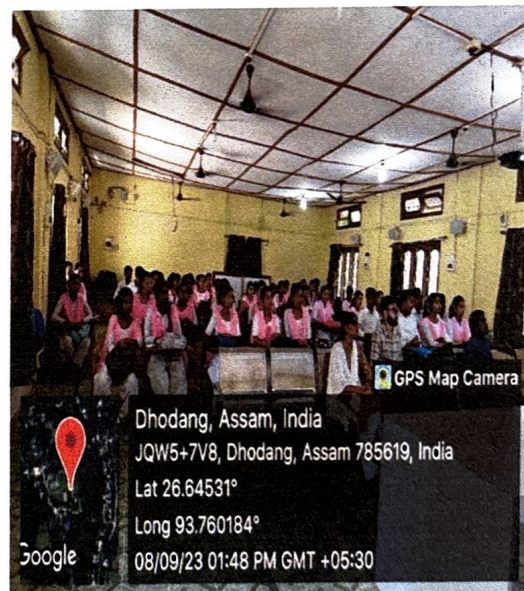
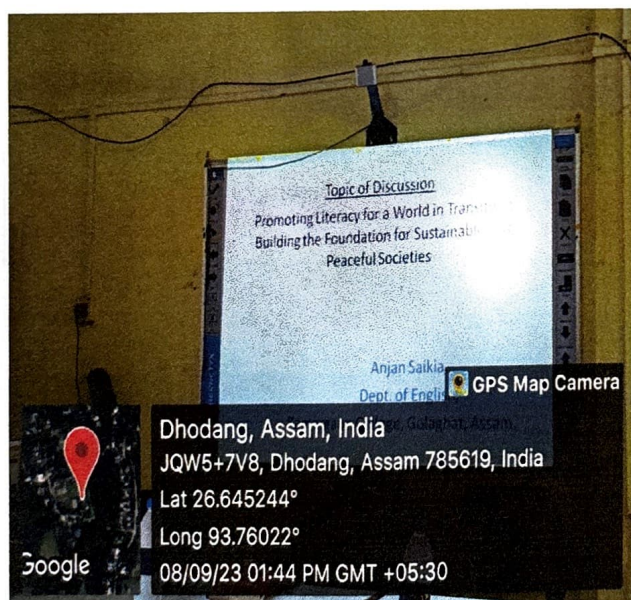


Talk on Promoting Literacy for a World in Transition; Building the Foundation for Sustainable and Peaceful Society

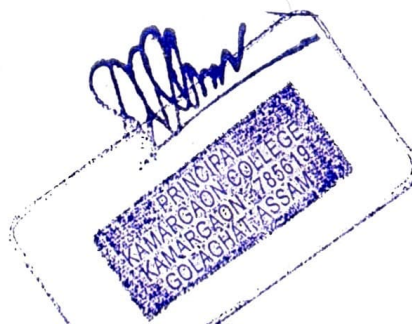
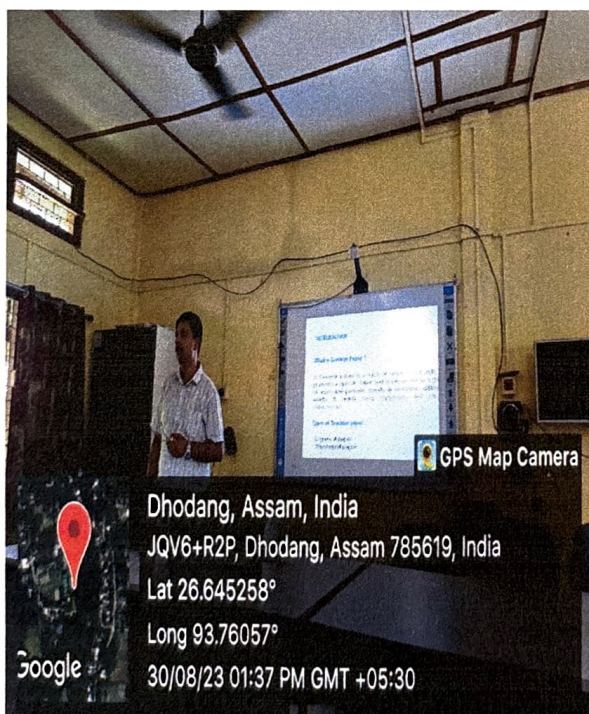


Workshop on Preparation of Seminar Paper

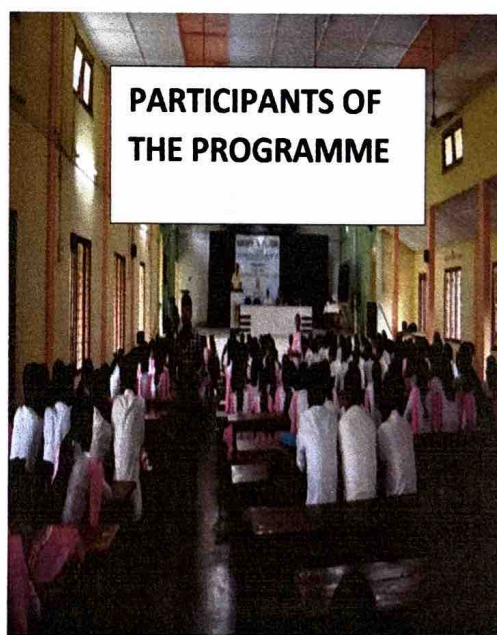


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Workshop cum motivational programme on *Road Towards Highlighting Professional Skills and Capacity Building Among Youths*

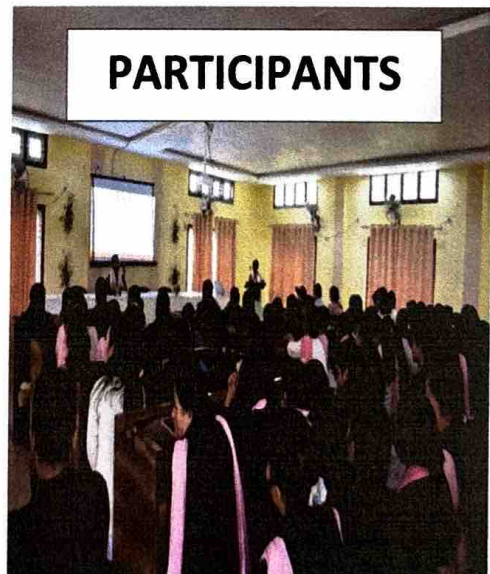

The event included a series of informative sessions and interactive discussions. Atul Kumar, IPS, SDPO, Bokakhat, Golaghat & Bitupon Chutia, Sub-Inspector, Bokakhat Police Station, Bokakhat, Golaghat took part in the programme as Resource Persons. The program began with surfacing of objectives by the principal who emphasized the importance of road safety in reducing accidents and saving lives. Both the Resource Persons shared insights on various aspects of road safety. Topics covered including importance of wearing seat belts and helmets, understanding traffic signals and signs, the dangers of distracted driving and driving under the influence, and pedestrian rights and safety measures. 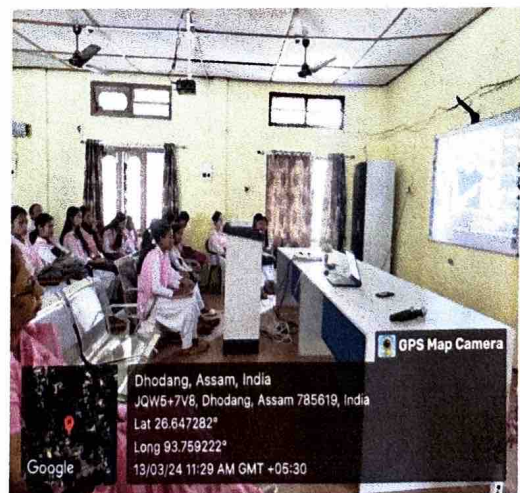
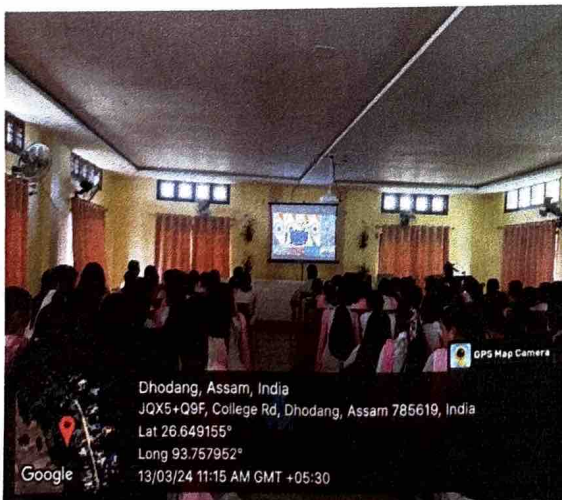
Snapshots of Daylong workshop on *Skill Development under Skill Yatra Mission* on 1st March, 2024

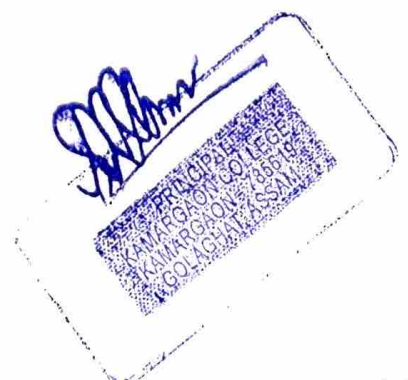

Workshop on *Vermi Compost and Mushroom Development*

On April 9, 2024, Kamargaon College organized a daylong workshop focused on Vermicomposting and Mushroom Development. This event aimed to enhance students' understanding of sustainable agricultural practices and promote innovative farming techniques. The workshop featured resource persons who are 6th-semester B.Sc. Agriculture students from Assam Agriculture University, Jorhat. The workshop focused on educating participants about the principles and practices of vermicomposting, introducing the techniques of mushroom cultivation as an alternative source of income and encouraging sustainable agricultural practices among students and the local farming community. The workshop commenced with an introductory session highlighting the importance of organic farming and waste management. The resource persons presented detailed insights into Vermicomposting and explained in detail the vermicomposting process and its benefits for soil health. They also arranged demonstration of the materials required for setting up a vermicompost system and initiated Hands-on activity where participants engaged in creating small-scale vermicompost bins. Further, they discussed in detail about Mushroom Development and gave an overview of various mushroom species suitable for cultivation, with a focus on oyster and button mushrooms. They provided step-by-step guidance on the mushroom growing process, including substrate preparation, inoculation, and harvesting. Discussions were held on the nutritional benefits of mushrooms and their role in enhancing food security. The workshop was highly interactive, with participants encouraged to ask questions and share their experiences related to composting and mushroom cultivation. Group discussions facilitated knowledge sharing and stimulated interest in these sustainable practices. Thus, the workshop on Vermicompost and Mushroom Development successfully provided valuable insights into sustainable agricultural practices. The participation of 74 students and other attendees from AAU not only enhanced the learning experience but also fostered a sense of community among aspiring agricultural professionals. The event concluded with a vote of thanks from the organizers, expressing gratitude to the resource persons and participants for their active involvement.

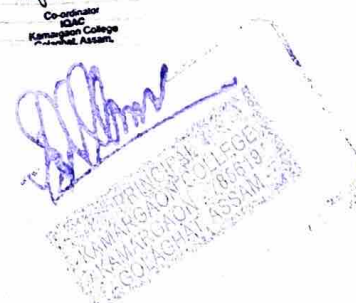

After the deliberations and decisions, the co-ordinator thanked the participants for their support and coordination at every stage.

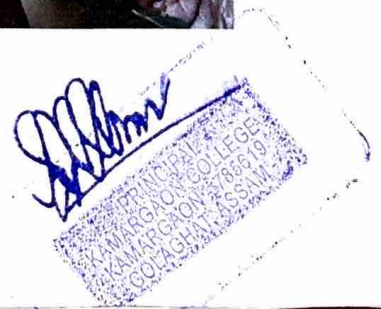

Talk on *Tobacco Prevention in Society*

On May 31, 2024, Kamargaon College conducted a workshop on "Tobacco Prevention in Society," with an aim to raise awareness about the detrimental effects of tobacco use and promoting strategies for prevention. This event was organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) as part of its commitment to enhancing health education within the community. The prime objectives of the workshop were to educate participants about the health risks associated with tobacco use, discuss the social and economic impacts of tobacco consumption, explore effective strategies for tobacco prevention and cessation and engage students and faculty in community outreach initiatives related to tobacco control. The workshop commenced with an introduction by the IQAC coordinator, who emphasized the importance of addressing tobacco use as a significant public health issue. Bidyut Deori, the resource person, delivered an insightful presentation covering various aspects of tobacco prevention. The workshop included Key topics like Health Impacts, Socio-Economic Effects, and Prevention Strategies. Mr. Deori highlighted the extensive health risks linked to tobacco, including respiratory diseases, cancer, and cardiovascular problems. Statistics illustrating the prevalence of tobacco use among youth were particularly alarming. The discussion also encompassed the economic burden of tobacco on families and healthcare systems, underlining how tobacco consumption perpetuates poverty and hinders economic development. Mr. Deori advocated for a multi-faceted approach to tobacco prevention, including educational campaigns aimed at young people, implementation of stricter regulations on tobacco sales and advertising, community support programs for individuals seeking to quit, engagement and Outreach. The workshop encouraged participants to actively engage in local community initiatives, such as awareness drives and school programs, to foster a tobacco-free environment. The session included an interactive Q&A segment where participants posed questions about effective cessation methods and the role of policy in tobacco control. This interaction underscored the importance of collaborative efforts in combating tobacco use.

Talk on Girl Child and Physical Changes during Adolescence & Sexual Harassment and Legal provisions

The Women Cell and the IQAC organised a workshop on *Girl Child and Physical Changes during Adolescence & Sexual Harassment and Legal provisions* on June 26, 2024 at Kamargaon Girls' High School, Golaghat. Focusing on critical issues affecting girl children, the event aimed to educate participants about the physical changes during adolescence and raise awareness about sexual harassment, alongside discussing relevant legal provisions. The workshop began with an introductory address by the organizers, highlighting the importance of understanding both physical and emotional changes during adolescence. In Session 1 on *Physical Changes During Adolescence* Mrs. Ankita Kalita led the first session, discussing the biological changes that occur during puberty, emotional and psychological aspects of adolescence and the significance of self-care and health awareness during this transformative period. Interactive activities included Q&A sessions where students expressed their concerns and shared experiences, fostering a supportive environment. In session 2 on *Sexual Harassment and Legal Provisions* Ms. Shamima Khanom Juna facilitated the second session, which covered definitions and examples of sexual harassment, the impact of harassment on mental health and educational pursuits and legal rights and provisions available to victims of sexual harassment, including relevant laws and support systems. The session encouraged students to speak up against harassment and provided practical advice on how to seek help. The workshop was well-received, with active participation from students. Many expressed gratitude for the information shared, noting that it empowered them to understand and navigate their adolescent years more confidently. The resource persons emphasized the importance of open communication with trusted adults regarding any issues faced. The workshop, in short, provided valuable insights into both the physical and emotional aspects of adolescence while addressing the pressing issue of sexual harassment. The collaboration between Kamargaon College and Kamargaon Girls' High School proved effective in fostering a safe and informative environment for young girls.

Talk on *Menstrual Hygiene for Girl Students*

A workshop cum awareness programme on *menstrual hygiene* was conducted at Mohuramukh Higher Secondary School in Golaghat on June 15, 2024. The workshop was organized by the Women Cell in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). The workshop aimed to educate and empower girl students about menstrual hygiene, break taboos surrounding menstruation, and promote health awareness. Through the workshop cum awareness programme, efforts were made to provide information on menstrual hygiene management, raise awareness about the importance of menstrual health, discuss myths and misconceptions related to menstruation and equip students with practical knowledge and skills for maintaining menstrual hygiene. The workshop was attended by 435 students from various grades, along with faculty members and representatives from the Women Cell and IQAC. In the inaugural session, Principal of Mohuramukh Higher Secondary School spoke briefly about the workshop and welcomed the Resource Persons namely Mrs. Mousumi Sinha, specialist for Mental Health, VKNRL, Golaghat and Dr. Karabi Saikia, doctor, VKNRL, Golaghat. The workshop included Presentation on menstrual hygiene, covering topics such as the menstrual cycle, hygiene practices, and the use of menstrual products and discussions of common myths and cultural stigmas associated with menstruation were held in the workshop. The event also comprised a practical demonstration on the use of sanitary products, including pads and menstrual cups. In the Q & A session, students raised queries related to menstrual hygiene, asked questions and shared their experiences. The workshop fostered an environment where students felt comfortable discussing menstruation and related issues and the participants gained a better understanding of the importance of maintaining menstrual hygiene for their health and well-being. It also helped in increasing awareness of the societal taboos and challenges faced by girls during menstruation and encouraging students to advocate for change. At the end of the workshop, Participants expressed gratitude for the knowledge shared and appreciated the opportunity to discuss issues that are often considered taboo. 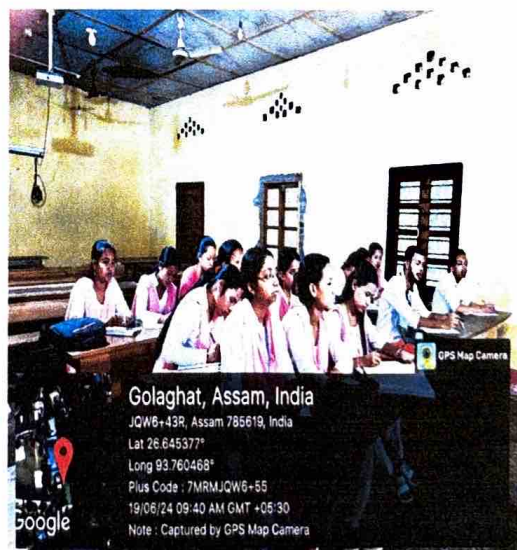

Talk on Terminology and Administrative Terminology

On June 19, 2024, the Department of Assamese organized an enlightening talk focused on the themes of *Terminology and Administrative Terminology*. The event was aimed to enhance understanding of terminological concepts and their significance in administrative contexts. The session was conducted by Mr. Rajib Hazarika, an Assistant Professor in the Department of Assamese, Rangasahi College in Majuli. Participants were engaged in discussions on how to develop clear and effective terminology in their respective fields. The session was interactive, with 20 participants actively engaging in discussions, sharing their experiences, and asking questions related to terminology challenges in their work. This interaction enriched the learning experience and fostered a collaborative atmosphere.

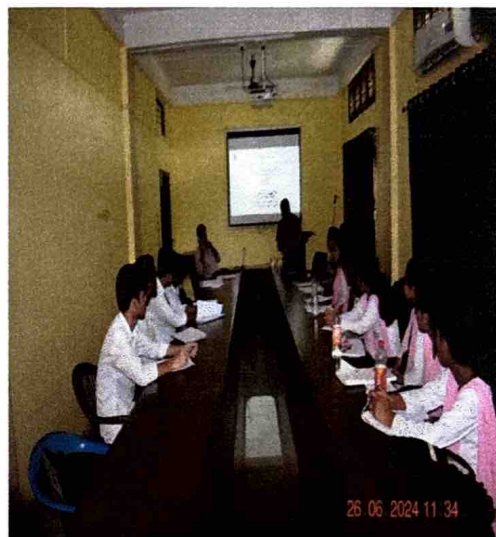
