

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NSS unit Kamargaon College conducted a Survey on youth *not in formal education or regular employment* at the adopted village Tarun Nagar to find out the actual number of unemployment in the village.

On March 27, 2023, the NSS Unit of Kamargaon College conducted a survey in the adopted village of Tarun Nagar to assess the number of youth not engaged in formal education or regular employment. The objective was to identify the actual unemployment rate and the educational status of the youth in the village.

The survey involved field visits and direct interactions with local households. Volunteers gathered data on the age, educational background, and employment status of young individuals aged 18-35 years. The findings revealed a significant number of youth were neither in formal education nor in regular employment, highlighting concerns about the lack of opportunities for skill development and employment in the region.

This survey will help in designing targeted interventions to enhance youth employability and educational access in Tarun Nagar. The NSS unit aims to collaborate with local authorities for remedial measures based on the survey results.


Survey of Youth Not in Formal Education or Regular Employment

A special survey has been ~~looking~~ out at adopted village Tarun Nagar by the NSS Volunteers of Kamargaon College Unit from 27th March '23. The basic aim of the survey was to find out the actual picture of the villagers. Generally the village youths are found illiterate and unemployed. The survey was aiming at the irregular and non-formal educated youths. In this survey, the surveyors were divided into five groups, six in each group. These groups covered about 65 households within four days. The survey had been completed with a poor number of reports. Maximum youths were ~~not~~ involved in Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL). But the volunteers joined and drove out the whole of survey with great zeal.

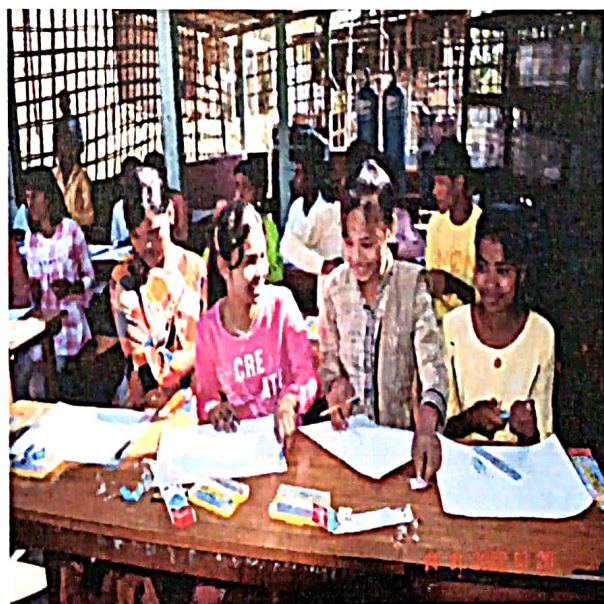

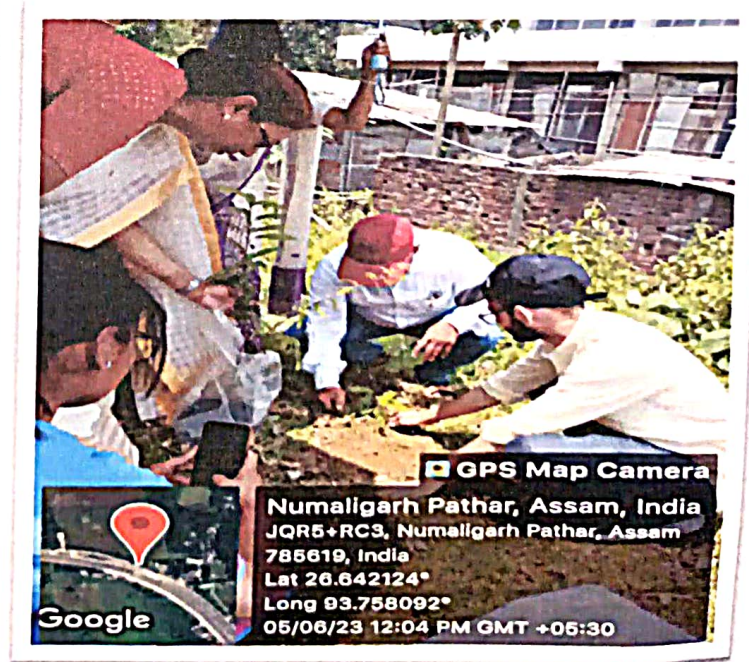


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Celebrating World Environment Day at neighboring areas of Kamargaon on 05.06.2023
