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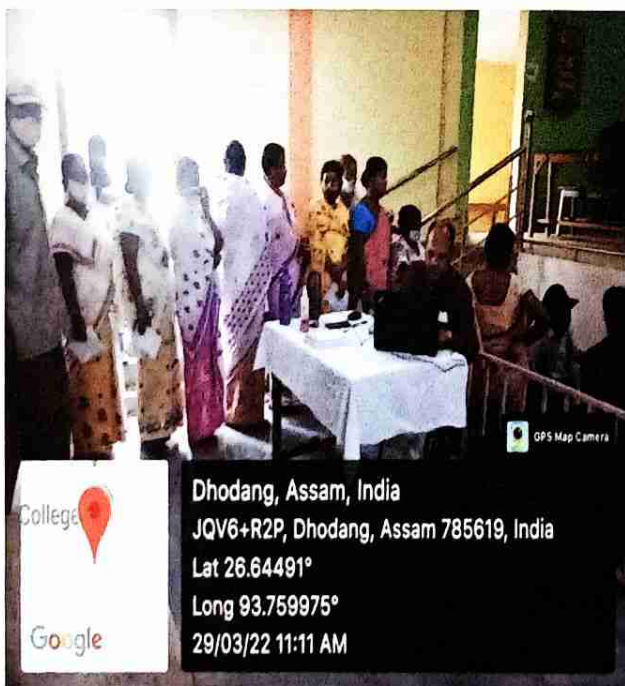
General Health Checking camp in the college campus for the students, Staff and Local People

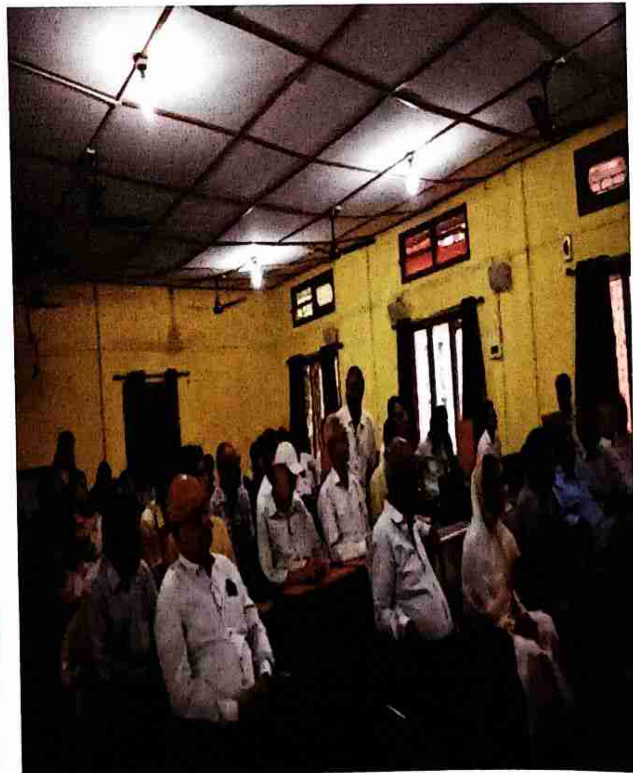

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NSS 7 day Special workshop Camp at Adopted village Tarun Nagar

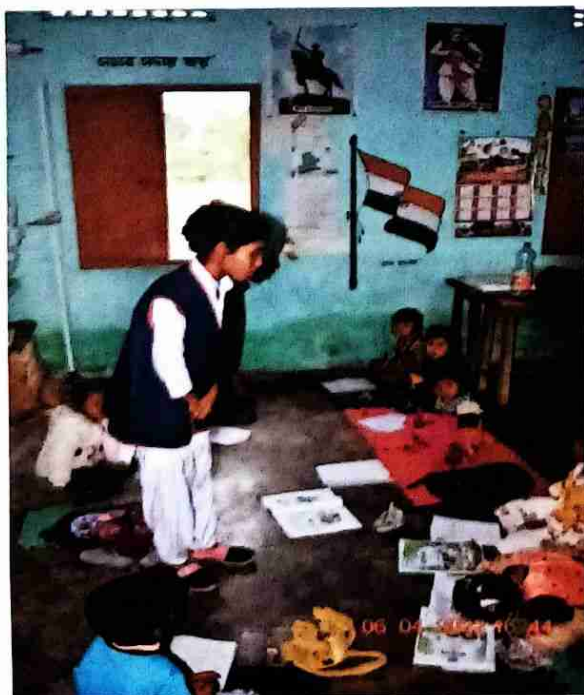
