The department has integrated Environment and Sustainability issues in curricular and cocurricular areas for optimum development of students and society. A detailed account of Environment and Sustainability addressed in curricular and co-curricular issues is provided here:

Environment and Sustainability

- 1. Classroom transaction of Environment and Sustainability is done through the teaching of courses like **Environmental Science** (VAC-3 for students of 2nd semester, FYUGP).
- 2. Environmental and sustainability issues are imparted to students through their participation in extension and community outreach programmes/ workshops like World Environment Day, Earth Day, Plantation and Cleanliness Drive, awareness on biodiversity, etc. conducted by the NSS, IQAC, Women Cell, and other cells/committees/club.
- 3. Environment and sustainability issues are imparted to students through the maintenance of a green campus and the promotion of electronic vehicular movements like e-rickshaws. The significance of solar energy is also explained to students and solar units have been installed in the campus.
- 4. Besides these curricular and co-curricular transactions, the **National Seminar** sponsored by govt. agency like ICSSR, New Delhi on **Climate Change and its Impact** in **North-East India** on November 9 & 10, 2023. Students were also given opportunities to become a part of the event.
- 5. Students of the department are enrolled in Add-on courses like **Vermicompost and Mushroom Development** to promote environmental awareness and sustainability.
