A one-day state level workshop on the topic **“Research Process, Manuscript Preparation and Ethical AI Tools”** was organized on 13.02.2026 by the Department of Economics in collaboration with the Department of Education, Kamargaon College. The workshop aimed to enhance research skills among students and faculty members while also introducing them to the ethical use of AI tools in academic work.
